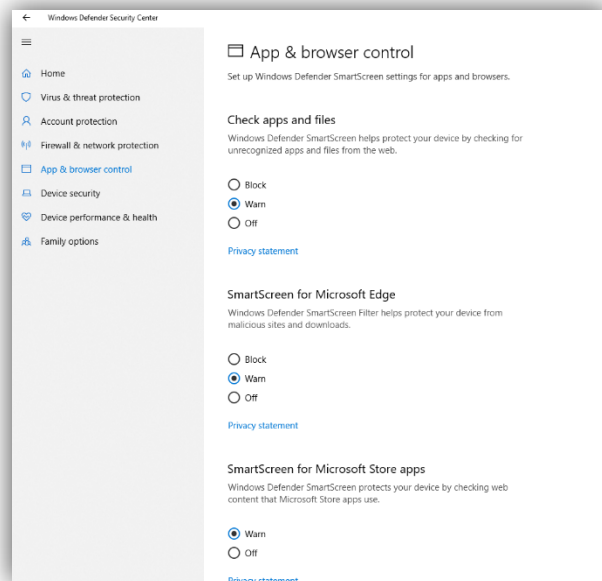

**SUBJECT:** Windows Defender SmartScreen Settings

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With increasing attacks over the Internet happening, it is important that Windows Defender SmartScreen settings are turned on, and the rules are set to **warn** in the event of an attack.

## HOW TO VERIFY WINDOWS DEFENDER SMARTSCREEN SETTINGS

- Step 1:** Click on the **Windows Defender** icon  located on the bottom right side of your taskbar under the *Show hidden icons* symbol or type **Windows Defender Security Center** in the *Search box* on bottom left side of your taskbar.
- Step 2:** On the *Windows Defender Security Center* screen, click the **App & browser control** option.
- Step 3:** As shown in the picture below, make sure the **Warn** option is selected under each of the *Windows Defender SmartScreen settings*' areas.



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
