UAN VERSION 2020.1

UAN version 2020.1 is being mailed Thursday, December 12, 2019. You should receive your copy by mail within a few days. Version 2020.1 is our end of the year release, and it must be installed to advance the UAN application from year 2019 to year 2020.

OHIO CYBERSECURITY WORKSHOP FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

This is not a UAN event however, the Ohio Department of Administrative Services has asked us to pass this invitation to all UAN clients.

To help improve the cybersecurity posture of Ohio local governments, the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Office of Information Security and Privacy, CyberOhio, and the National Governors Association are partnering to host a one-day cybersecurity workshop. Ohio local government leaders are invited to a one-day event on December 17th to cover basic methods of computer security.

Computer security is a critical concern for private and public organizations alike. While criminals continue to look for ways to make money by exploiting computer system and workforce weaknesses, following basic procedures can go a long way toward reducing exposure.

This workshop is free to Ohio local government leaders and will focus on using the Center for Internet Security (CIS) Basic Security Controls, one of the security frameworks adopted by the State of Ohio for agencies. There are 20 controls, the top six of which are considered basic and the most critical. CIS reports that fully implementing these basic controls will stop 85% of cybersecurity threats. The workshop will also feature presentations by representatives of the Ohio National Guard and Ohio Homeland Security.
